

Automated Monitoring of Transit Lanes

MARTA Rapid Summerhill is under construction and scheduled for revenue service in 2025. Successful operation from the beginning is critical.

- ✓ "Cameras are a more equitable, sustainable, and effective option than relying on a police officer to enforce dedicated bus lanes." - National Association of City Transportation Officials (NACTO)
 - Reduces law enforcement personnel costs and time commitment
 - Provides an effective deterrent
 - ✓ Reduces shoulder congestion
 - Minimal construction compared to physical barriers





MARTOC Committee Meetings

Three committee meetings have been held to discuss and hear from stakeholders on noise, school zone and bus lane camera enforcement.

- ✓ Meetings Dates: 6/7, 7/27 & 10/17
- ✓ MARTOC Chair Silcox spearheading bus camera enforcement legislation





Legislative Proposal

Modifies OCGA Title 40 pertaining to motor vehicles and traffic.

- Bars non-transit vehicles from entering the dedicated transit lane unless authorized by a traffic control device or in an emergency.
- Permits local law enforcement to monitor and enforce transit lanes.
- ✓ Authorizes jurisdictions to engage a third-party vendor to provide automated camera enforcement services.
- Establishes GDOT as the regulatory authority and issuer for automated camera devices.





Penalties & Due Process

Violations captured by law enforcement:

- Misdemeanor
- ✓ Fine: \$50/ \$100/ \$150/ \$150 +1 point
- ✓ Mirrors "distracted driving" fines

Violations captured by automated camera:

- ✓ Civil monetary penalty
- Does not affect motor vehicle record
- ✓ Fine: \$175/\$350 + fees capped at \$25

Due Process in line with other traffic tickets





Regulation

GDOT will have the authority to issue permits and regulate the use of automated cameras.

- ✓ Local governments must apply for a permit to operate per GDOT's "rules and regulations" and are subject to inspection.
- Revenue is not considered in evaluating applications but is collected by local jurisdictions and must be used "to fund public safety initiatives or maintenance of transit vehicle lanes or both."
- ✓ Visible signs must forewarn motorists.

 - ✓ Eg. expansion of CDL language test to Spanish
- ✓ Tort reform
