



Community Stakeholder Interviews: What We Heard

In the summer of 2010, over 30 community stakeholder interviews were held to gauge community sentiments regarding transit investment in the I-20 East Corridor. The following presents the percentage of interviewees who mentioned the same issue.

Rail would attract riders/development/public support

Need improved connectivity/transportation options

Need improved/more reliable transit service

Congestion in corridor, particularly I-20

Rail is the appropriate technology for the corridor

Aging population will need mobility options

Transit should serve Rockdale County

Little opposition expected

Need to educate the public about transit

Opposition due to fear of crime and NIMBY's

Need to avoid historic neighborhoods

East Atlanta an appropriate location for station
