What is the **More MARTA Atlanta** Program?

More MARTA Atlanta is the largest transit investment in four decades – \$2.5 billion over the next 40 years. Funded by the half-penny sales tax overwhelmingly passed in 2016 by Atlanta voters, the program includes improvements to existing service and investment in a variety of transit projects and system-wide enhancements.





How did we get here?

More MARTA Atlanta has been the people's program from the beginning.

- Vote overwhelming approved by Atlanta voters in November 2016
- Public engagement in 2016 and 2017 conducted
- Public input has played a significant role in developing the proposed project list
- Original program list of 70 projects totalling \$11.5B exceeded the program's \$2.5 budget and public input has played a significant role in right-sizing it to the currently proposed project list



How will More MARTA improve Atlanta transit?

- Designed to provide greater transit service frequency, reliability, and accessibility
- The More MARTA Atlanta projects connect 126 unique neighborhoods throughout the City
- Increases Atlantans' access to jobs by 56%*
- Provides access to more than 70 healthcare facilities, 83 grocery stores, and 115 schools and universities
- Increases access to transit to communities with large minority or low-income populations by 61%

*Access to jobs within a 45-minute timeframe in comparison to the current high frequency service

The program is shaped by guiding principles focused on a balanced approach to improving transit service, accessibility, and connectivity throughout the City of Atlanta. To review the guiding principles, visit www.itsmarta.com/moremarta.

- New transit centers and station upgrades


