What's new?

The new bus network uses new and improved strategies to make your service easier and more convenient. The new service will have:

- More frequent routes**
 The new network will feature 15-minute service frequency in 17 corridors, plus other frequency increases in many other places.
- Simpler routes, fewer transfers**
 New and improved fixed route services will operate more efficiently and save you time.
- Timed transfer locations**
 Key connections will be coordinated to reduce wait time. Several locations will receive upgraded amenities and pedestrian features.
- More consistent schedules**
 All routes and Reach zones will operate every day, every week, and many feature better frequency mid-day and on weekends.
- MARTA Reach on-demand service**
 New on-demand services will take you around the neighborhood or connect you to other MARTA services for longer trips.
