Ride with Respect/Code of Conduct Suspensions as of October 23, 2022

- 58% increase YTD
- 4014 vs. 1666 = 2348 additional suspensions
- Mostly due to 90-day detail from April – June 2022
- 47 permanent bans YTD
- 142 “365” suspensions YTD
- 236 arrests for violation of suspension
- New MARTA Intranet link to permanent ban names/pictures
- MPD CIU completing monthly report on all employee assaults/case status

2022 RWR Revisions

- Repeat Offender:

A person who receives three (3) citations (which are not appealed or if appealed, a final determination of guilt has been made) within a ninety (90) day period shall receive a three hundred and sixty-five (365) day suspension. A person who receives four (4) citations (which are not appealed or if appealed, a final determination of guilt has been made) within a ninety (90) day period shall be permanently banned from the system.

2022 RWR Revisions

- Violations with new 365 Day Suspension:
- Indecent exposure.
- Stealing or willfully damaging MARTA property
- Assault or threat of assault.
- Hindering or disturbing the operation, operator, or passengers of a bus or rail car.
- Fighting.
- Harassing or threatening MARTA passengers or employees. This includes following or stalking.
- Entering the operators' cab or driver's seat.
- *These violations are in conjunction with criminal charges.*


