RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A ONE-TIME COST OF LIVING BONUS FOR THE RETIREES AND BENEFICIARIES OF THE MARTA NON-REPRESENTED PENSION PLAN

WHEREAS, the MARTA Non-Represented Pension Plan (the "Plan") requires the Management Pension Committee (the "Committee") for the Plan to annually review and consider the adequacy of retirees' pension benefits under the Plan with respect to a cost-of-living adjustment ("COLA") and MARTA's financial condition and ability to fund a COLA, and, if warranted, recommend a COLA to the Board of Directors for consideration.

WHEREAS, the Committee adopted a Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) Policy (the "Policy"), effective October 12, 2017, to establish procedures and guidelines for such review by the Committee.

WHEREAS the Committee during its annual review, in accordance with the Plan and with the guidance of the Plan's actuary, considered, among other items, the rate of return for the plan year ended December 31, 2024, the funding position of the Plan, and Consumer Price Index (CPI) data for the most recent preceding twelve month period, and determined that a cost of living adjustment would be appropriate.

WHEREAS, the Committee has recommended a cost-of-living bonus for Retirees and Beneficiaries in pay status as of January 1, 2025, in the Plan (collectively, "Eligible Participants") in the form of a one-time lump sum equivalent to an additional monthly check with a minimum payment of \$1,200 and a maximum payment based upon the monthly benefit payment that the retiree and/or beneficiary is already entitled, payable or deferred, as applicable, by January 2026.

WHEREAS the Plan's actuary has determined that this action will have an

approximate one-time cost of \$3,113,561 to the Plan.

Participants (as described above) in the form of a one-time lump sum payment equivalent

already entitled, payable or deferred as applicable by January 2026. Said payment shall

be paid separate from the regular monthly benefit payment.

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority (MARTA) recognizes the unique opportunity presented by hosting major international and national events, including the 2026 FIFA World Cup and the 2028 Super Bowl, to enhance brand visibility and generate additional advertising revenue;

WHEREAS, MARTA's current advertising policy prohibits the display or sale of alcohol-related advertising on Authority property;

WHEREAS, MARTA staff have proposed a temporary suspension of this restriction during the months of May through August 2026, for the FIFA World Cup and during the months January through March 2028 for Super Bowl, to align with industry norms and capture increased advertising demand associated with these events;

WHEREAS, allowing alcohol advertising during these defined event periods would generate short-term revenue while maintaining MARTA's commitment to responsible and community-sensitive advertising standards;

WHEREAS, this measure is temporary in nature and shall not constitute a permanent amendment to MARTA's existing Advertising Policy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority hereby authorizes the temporary allowance of alcohol advertising during the months of May through August in 2026 for FIFA World Cup and during the months of January through March in 2028 for Super Bowl.
