We are thrilled to provide you with the latest updates on our progress this month. The Department of Watershed Management has finished relocating utilities south of Ormond Street on Hank Aaron Drive. Our construction team

has begun block-by-block construction along Hank Aaron Drive south of Ormond Street. Big changes are happening at the Carver Station platform with the addition of the bus charges shown above.

Please note:

- There is no on-street parking in construction zones, including the detours happening along Hank Aaron Drive. Please pay attention to signage.
- Construction will take place on Saturday, December 13th, along Hank Aaron Drive from Weyman Avenue to McDonough Boulevard, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Construction Impacts:




Please be aware of traffic lane closures and detours for pedestrians and cyclists due to essential road work at the following locations:

- Hank Aaron Drive south of Ormond Street: Local traffic only allowed during lane closures. All other traffic will be detoured according to phase of work.
- Along Mitchell Street and along MLK Jr Drive: Lane closures, sidewalk closures, and pedestrian detours.



Effective December 1, 2026 to Spring 2026, bus routes 49 and 55 are detoured due to construction. Please refer to the map above for the locations of the detoured routes. 
On-Street Parking Impacts:

On-street parking will be closed in locations along the route during the next phase of construction as the team continues to prepare for future *Rapid* station installations and road widening. All drivers along the route should adhere to posted signage such as the restricting parking access signs. Please refrain from blocking vehicles parked in prohibited on-street parking spots. Any vehicles that obscure construction activity will be towed at the owner's expense.

On-street parking spots are closed in the following locations:

- Hank Aaron Drive from Ormond Street to McDonough Boulevard intersection
- Along Mitchell Street and MLK Jr Drive at various locations depending on active construction
