

Happy Fall, Everyone!

We are excited to share updates on our progress this month. Our team has started roadway milling and resurfacing along Hank Aaron Drive. Next up is the final platform construction, bringing us closer to a fully operational Bus

Rapid Transit (BRT) system.

Additionally, the Department of Watershed Management is in the process of relocating utilities south of Ormond Street on Hank Aaron Drive. Following this, our construction team will begin block-by-block repaving.

Please note:

- There is no on-street parking in construction zones, including along Hank Aaron Drive and Mitchell Street. Please pay attention to signage.
- Construction will take place on Saturday, November 15th, at the intersection of Hank Aaron Drive and Ormond Street, from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- There will be upcoming traffic detours that are estimated to start on December 1st at the intersection of Hank Aaron Drive and McDonough Boulevard on the north side of the tracks. Bus routes 155, 55 and 49 will be impacted. Further details on bus detours coming soon.

Construction Impacts:



Please be aware of traffic lane closures and detours for pedestrians and cyclists due to essential road work at the following locations:


- Hank Aaron Drive south of Ormond Street: Local traffic only allowed during lane closures, all other traffic will be detoured according to phase of work.
- Hank Aaron Drive from Ormond Street to Southern Terminus: Lane closures, road closures, sidewalk closures, pedestrian, and vehicular detours.
- Intersection of Hank Aaron and Haygood Avenue: Installation of platforms utilities and sidewalk improvements.
- Hank Aaron southbound just north of the railroad tracks at McDonough Boulevard: Ongoing installation of Carver Station, including the bus turnaround lane.



Bus Stop Impacts



Bus stops that are covered with a red bag are temporarily closed due to construction of MARTA *Rapid* A-Line and will not be served. If your bus stop is closed, please use the nearest open bus stop.

Bus routes 155, 55, and 49 are anticipated to experience detours starting December 1st. Information on the specific detour routes will be upcoming soon on the <u>bus reroute website</u> and future construction alert.

Several existing bus stops along the corridor will be intermittently impacted by construction. Please refer to the rider alert above for more information on how to identify open or closed bus stops. 
On-Street Parking Impacts:

On-street parking will be closed in locations along the route during the next phase of construction as the team continues to prepare for future *Rapid* station installations and road widening. All drivers along the route should adhere to posted signage such as the restricting parking access signs. Please refrain from blocking vehicles parked in on-street parking spots along Hank Aaron between Crumley Street and Ormond Street. Any vehicles that obscure construction activity will be towed at the owner's expense.

On-street parking spots are closed in the following locations:

- Hank Aaron Drive between Crumley Street and Ormond Street
- MLK Jr. Drive between Washington Street and Shirley C. Franklin Boulevard
- Mitchell Street between Shirley C. Franklin Boulevard and Washington Street
- Capital Avenue SW between Capital Square SW and Memorial Drive SW
- Hank Aaron Drive from Ormond Street to Southern Terminus
