



### Happy October Everyone!

Our team has made great progress this month with roadway milling and resurfacing. Up next, we'll begin working on the final platform; bringing us another step closer to a fully operational Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) system.

We're still finalizing plans for the work south of Ormond Street on Hank Aaron Drive. More details will be shared as soon as they're available. In the meantime, we remain committed to moving the project forward while minimizing impacts on the community.

#### Please note:

- Construction will take place on Saturday, October 11th, along Mitchell Street, between Shirley C. Franklin Boulevard and Washington Street SW, from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. During this time, no on-street parking will be allowed in this area.
- Due to a full street closure for film production, construction on *Rapid* A-Line along Mitchell Street between Shirley C. Franklin Boulevard and Washington Street SW will be delayed. On street parking in this area will remain unavailable until the work is complete.

# Construction Impacts:



Please be aware of traffic lane closures and detours for pedestrians and cyclists due to essential road work at the following locations:

- Mitchell Street and Shirley C Franklin Boulevard: Lane closures, road closures, sidewalk closures, pedestrian, and vehicular detours surrounding Mitchell Street, Shirley C Franklin Boulevard, and Washington Street
- MLK Jr Drive and Capitol Avenue: Lane closures, sidewalk closures, pedestrian, and vehicular detours surrounding MLK Jr Drive, Piedmont Avenue, Decatur Street and Jesse Hill Jr Drive
- Capitol Avenue northbound between Fulton Street and Memorial Drive
- Right exit ramp from I-20 westbound onto Capitol Avenue
- Intersection of Hank Aaron and Haygood Avenue: Installation of platforms utilities and sidewalk improvements
- Hank Aaron southbound just north of the railroad tracks at McDonough Boulevard: Ongoing installation of Carver Station, including the bus turnaround lane


All Revised Traffic Control Plans Along the Route (Active October 2025)

# On-Street Parking Impacts:

On street parking will be closed in locations along the route during the next phase of construction as the team continues to prepare for future *Rapid* station installations and road widening. All drivers along the route should adhere to posted signage such as the restricting parking access signs. Please refrain from blocking vehicles parked in on-street parking spots along Hank Aaron between Crumley Street and Glenn Street. Any vehicles that obscure construction activity will be towed at the owners expense.

On-Street Parking spots are closed in the following locations:

- MLK Jr. Drive between Washington Street and Shirley C. Franklin Boulevard
- Mitchell Street between Shirley C. Franklin Boulevard and Washington Street
- Capital Avenue SW between Capital Square SW and Memorial Drive SW

<u>Terminal South</u> is a vibrant adaptive reuse project in Peoplestown, located steps from the Atlanta BeltLine and the future terminus of MARTA's *Rapid* A-line at **1161 Ridge Avenue SW, Atlanta, GA 30315**. What began as two vacant warehouses is transforming into a community hub.

At the heart of Terminal South is Switchman Hall, a chef-driven restaurant collective featuring 18 unique dining concepts. The development also includes locally owned retail shops, creative workspaces, and a tenant-funded scholarship program that reinvests in the neighborhood. With its mix of food, culture, and community impact, Terminal South is set to become a gathering place for all of Atlanta.

Now open at Terminal South: Offbeat Books, Sugar Polish Nail Bar, and Nadora Sky Permanent Jewelry with microrestaurants opening soon!
