



As fall approaches, this month the team has been focusing on creating a plan for work south of Ormond Street. Through ongoing roadwork improvements, the team has found existing utilities are too shallow to meet City of Atlanta standards on the route section of Hank Aaron Drive between Ormond Street and Ridge Avenue.

Previously, plans to conduct construction in the area were going to require greater impact on residents and businesses. Adjustments to construction are being made to address the infrastructural issues while also minimizing disruption.

## Monthly Station Feature


Intended to improve rider confidence and efficiency, the Monthly Station Feature aims to ensure a smoother, more informed transit experience for all passengers. Please check out this month's station feature below!

### **Tactile Pavement**

• Safety at Platform Edges: Enhances overall passenger safety near platform edges.

- Alerts Passengers: Warns passengers when they are nearing the edge of a platform.
- Accessibility for Visually Impaired: Supports safe navigation for visually impaired individuals.
- Guidance and Warning Cues: Offers critical tactile or audio cues to guide and warn passengers.





## Construction Impacts:



Please anticipate traffic lane closures and pedestrian and bicycle detours for necessary road widening work at the following locations:

- Mitchell Street and Shirley C Franklin Boulevard: Lane closures, road closures, sidewalk closures, pedestrian, and vehicular detours surrounding Mitchell Street, Shirley C Franklin Boulevard, and Washington Street
- MLK Jr Drive and Capitol Avenue: Lane closures, sidewalk closures, pedestrian, and vehicular detours surrounding MLK Jr Drive, Piedmont Avenue, Decatur Street and Jesse Hill Jr Drive
- Haygood Avenue and Hank Aaron Drive: Lane and sidewalk closures along Hank Aaron Drive moving south from the intersection of Haygood Avenue
- Capitol Avenue northbound between Fulton Street and Memorial Drive
- Right exit ramp from I-20 westbound onto Capitol Avenue

Traffic lane shifts and sidewalk detours continue at the following locations:

- Hank Aaron southbound just north of the railroad tracks at McDonough Boulevard: Ongoing installation of Carver Station, including the bus turnaround lane
- Intersection of Hank Aaron and Haygood Avenue: Installation of the southbound shelter and sidewalk improvements

We encourage you to plan accordingly, as these lane closures may cause some delays. Please view traffic plans below and monitor our website at <u>itsmarta.com/aline</u> for more information.

Lane Closures: Capitol Avenue northbound between Fulton Street and Memorial Drive and right exit ramp from I-20 westbound onto Capitol Avenue

Lane Closures: Hank Aaron southbound just north of railroad tracks at McDonough Boulevard


Lane Closures: Hank Aaron and Ormond Street

Several existing bus stops along the corridor will be intermittently impacted by construction. Please refer to the rider alert above for more information on how to identify open or closed bus stops. ### On-Street Parking Impacts:

On street parking will be closed in locations along the route during the next phase of construction as the team continues to prepare for future *Rapid* station installations and road widening. All drivers along the route should adhere to posted signage such as the restricting parking access signs. Please refrain from blocking vehicles parked in on-street parking spots along Hank Aaron between Crumley Street and Glenn Street. Any vehicles that obscure construction activity will be towed at the owners expense.

On-Street Parking spots are closed in the following locations:

- MLK Jr. Drive between Central Avenue and Pryor Street
- Mitchell Street starting mid-block between Pryor Street and Central Avenue and ending mid-block between Central Avenue and Washington Street
- Central Avenue between Trinity Avenue and Mitchell Street
- The intersection of Mitchell Street and Forsyth Street
