Meeting Notice: MARTA Connect 400 Project to Meet with Northridge & Roberts Dr. Neighborhood Associations

Meeting date & time: Thursday, June 12, 7:00 p.m.

Meeting place: Dunwoody Community Church, located at Dunwoody Club Rd. / Mt. Vernon

Meeting purpose: MARTA representatives will meet with residents of home owners associations located in the Sandy Springs panhandle neighborhoods bordering Roberts Drive and Northridge Road, as well as those bordering GA 400 along Spaulding Drive to provide an overview of its Connect 400 Project.

Background: MARTA's Connect 400 Project would extend MARTA service, either by heavy rail or rapid-bus line north from the current North Springs MARTA Station to Windward Parkway, the GA 400 interchange just north of where North Point shopping mall is located.

MARTA is preparing to enter phase two of its multi-stage planning process, which is required by the federal Department of Transportation, from which would MARTA plans to seek federal funds to supplement state and local funds to construct the expansion.

Preliminary studies favor expanding MARTA either by heavy rail, which could use existing DOT right of way along GA 400 north, including the possibility of continuing north along the east side of the highway from the existing North Springs Station, or by using specially designated rapid-bus lanes along GA 400. Preliminary plans also call for building five or six MARTA stations, from Northridge Road north to Windward Parkway, where a regional transportation station (similar to North Springs) would be built.

MARTA has previously briefed residents in Alpharetta and Roswell, although Sandy Springs residents, particularly those likely impacted by a future station at Northridge, have not been briefed. This meeting will provide an opportunity for that briefing.

It is important to note that the City of Sandy Springs and the Board of Fulton County Schools have sent letters to MARTA stating their preference for any future MARTA heavy rail expansion to occur on the WEST side of GA 400 versus the EAST side of the highway, due to the potential impact to two elementary schools (Dunwoody Springs Charter, Woodland Forest) and substantial residential developments on the east side of GA 400.



General Themes

- Lack of transportation funding
- Need for 'last mile' circulation
- Need feeder system to 400 transit
- Need for transit-oriented development around the stations
- Desire to preserve visual aesthetics, including river buffers and tree buffers
- Phase transit improvements to build market/ ridership
- There is no 'reverse commute' on 400, both directions bad during peak hours
- Need to improve existing MARTA bus routes and add more
- Georgia 400 corridor is preferred alignment
- Community support for Heavy Rail Transit







Public Opinion Survey Highlights

- Majority of residents believe traffic congestion is a real problem
- Almost 80% of respondents agreed that a better public transportation system is needed
- Over 60 % of all respondents indicated they would use public transportation more often if it could get them to places they need to go
- Ironically, almost 60 % of respondents generally agreed that improving the local roadways is the best way to solve the areas traffic problems
- Almost 80% of respondents indicated they either strongly approve or approve of expansion of MARTA up GA-400 to the Forsyth County line
- Heavy rail preferred by 40% of respondents
- Light rail is preferred by 37%
- BRT in HOT/HOV preferred by 11%; fixed guideway by 6%.












